# NIGHT THORN

v. 2 FOR WOODWIND QUINTET

**Flute:**

Key Clicks: air can be very light to non-existent; clicking should be rapid, rhythmic, and erratic

**Oboe:**

Portamento - if necessary, these can be performed using lip glissando technique.

**Bb Clarinet/Oboe:**

For "Laughing":

1. Chaotic swooping/scooping/noodling



Perform this by scooping while simultaneously wiggling your fingers on the keys. Animalistic sounding, or like hysterical babbling.

2. Slap tongue



Aim for clear pitch and as sharp/percussive an attack as you can achieve.

3. Timbral trill/alternating fingerings



**Bassoon:**

1. Portamento - if necessary, these can be performed using lip glissando technique.
